+ Procedures

Leveled Library Checking Out Materials

1. Click on Destiny Link on the Desktop
2. Click on Login
3. Enter username: leveled
4. Click Login
5. Click on Circulation Tab
6. Click on Check Out
7. Type your last name
8. Click Go
9. Click on your name in the list
10. Scan each bag (wait to see the title pop on the screen before scanning the next bag)
11. Click Reset
12. In the menu bar, click Safari and Quit to close Destiny
13. When finished with your bag, return them to the LMC.
